

M.S. in Dental Surgery

Since 2018, the Higher Education Ordinance mandates a new degree requirement that encompasses comprehensive educational objectives relating to the understanding of men's violence against women and intimate partner violence. These objectives have been further specified and tailored to various educational programs at Swedish universities, highlighting specific competencies, skills, judgments, approaches, and formulated content. Below are objectives in the Dental surgery program from one of the universities.

Objectives

Knowledge and understanding

- Men's violence against women and violence in close relationships.
- The Convention on the Rights of the Child, the rights of the child, children and violence in close relationships.
- Being able to account for children at risk, violence in close relationships, and the obligation to report suspicions of such.
- Demonstrate knowledge of men's violence against women and violence in close relationships in relation to dental and jaw injuries.

Competence and skills

- Being able to identify signs of men's violence against women and violence in close relationships.
- Being able to reflect on fictional situations regarding violence in close relationships.
